## **“Join SEA Club”**

San Pedro, CA – Kindergarten through 2nd grade students enrolled in Cabrillo Marine Aquarium’s SEA Club (Science Education Afternoons) will learn and have fun exploring the local marine environment. The club will meet from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on four consecutive Mondays, February 23 through March 16.

Students, under the guidance of CMA’s education staff, will have an opportunity to use microscopes and learn about the relationship between humans and the ocean. We will trek to the tidepools of Cabrillo Beach, watch crabs scurry, snails glide, and learn about the marvels of mud.

The aquarium’s live animals, preserved specimen collections (shells, fish, fossils, bones, etc.), lab and field equipment, and library will be available for use and the aquarium will serve as a base station for ocean exploration.

The cost for four weekly sessions is \$30 (\$27 Friends members) and includes a SEA Club t-shirt. Financial assistance is available.
